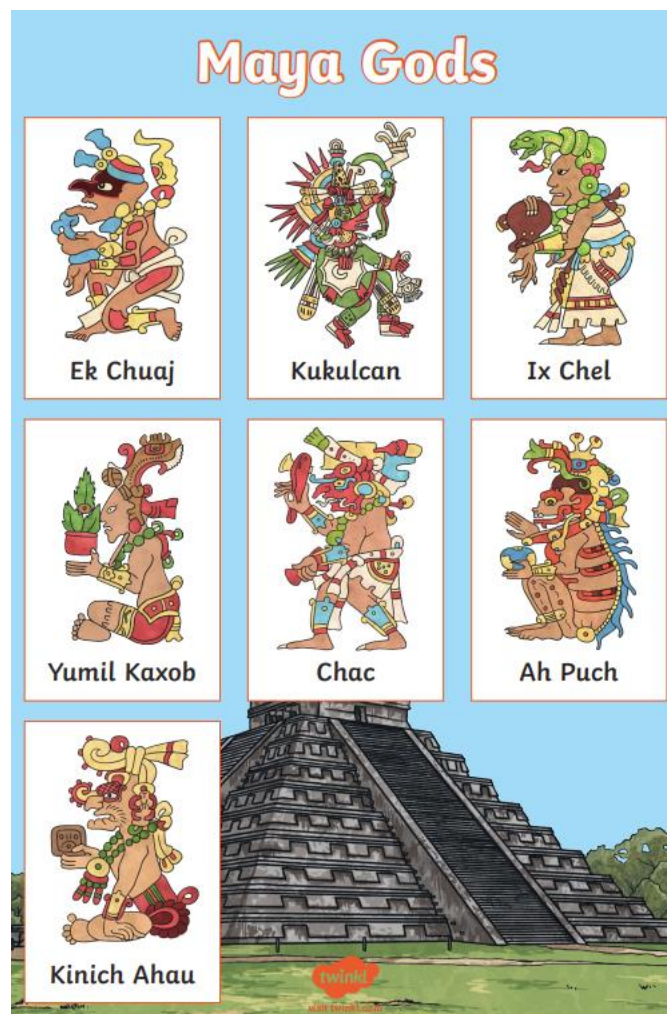


Oak - Extended Home Learning Project Autumn 1 - History

This term in History, we are learning about the Ancient Maya. Our enquiry question - Why did the Ancient Maya change the way they lived? - will investigate the Maya civilisation which reached its peak around AD 900 and give us the opportunity to appreciate the achievements of a society that existed at the same time as the Anglo-Saxons and Viking in our country.

One of the key aspects of Ancient Maya life we will be looking at is their religious beliefs and practices. My challenge to Oak class is to investigate the Maya gods and produce a piece of work showing what you have found out. You could focus on one of the gods, or look at several different ones. What about choosing two and comparing them?



You can do this in any way you want. You could create a PowerPoint fact file, a story that includes one of the gods, a poem or a piece of artwork. The choices are endless!
